Dear Verizon Open Development OEM:

As a valued Verizon Device Manufacturer, we are sending you this notification as part of our commitment to providing you with the best wireless experience possible. You currently have M2M/IoT devices using our CDMA network, this serves as a reminder notice of upcoming Network changes that impact the use of these devices.

As previously communicated, Verizon plans to sunset its CDMA network (1X/EVDO, 2G/3G) on December 31st, 2019. After June 30th, 2018 we will stop activating new CDMA equipment. However, during the transition, we will continue to support the following account services through July 1st, 2019: Device ID change, MDN Change, Price Plan Change, Suspend and Resume, Reactivate MDN and Multimode supporting CDMA Voice (LTE with CDMA).

We are requesting all Device Manufacturers to upload enough replacement ESN's to Verizon's Device Management Database before June 30th, 2018 to cover replacement inventory for any broken and defective devices through July 1st, 2019.
